





Wet weather has slowed progress with the containers, but the latest estimate is for delivery to take place within the next four weeks.

> The good news is that North Yorkshire Building Control have now given full approval for our plans to create an environmentally friendly, energy efficient building.

The containers have been around the world several times, and will now become the repurposed shell of the community shed.



The steel panels removed as part of the conversion, will be recycled.

The walls and ceiling will contain sheep's wool slabs. Great for thermal and sound insulation, as well as being fire resistant, non-toxic, and pleasant to work with.

Upcycled pallet wood will line some of the internal walls, providing additional insulation, as well as creating an interesting feature.





A section of the roof will have a sedum based, lightweight green-roof system installed.
